## Overview of Spiritual Gifts in the New Testament

Lists of Gifts in the New Testament

- 1. Romans 12:3-8
- 2. Ephesians 4:7
- 3. 1 Corinthians 12:7-10
- 4. 1 Corinthians 12:27-30

Four Divisions of Gifts (1 Corinthians 12:4-7)

- 1. Charisma- Grace Gifts
- 2. Diakonia- Ministries
- 3. Energma- Operations
- 4. Phanerosis- Manifestations

One Way of Understanding the Lists of Gifts with regard to the four divisions:

- 1. Charisma- Grace Gifts (Romans 12:3-8)
- 2. Diakonia- Ministries (Ephesians 4:7; 1 Corinthians 12:27-28)
- 3. Energma- Operations (no lists in the N.T.; possible example of Peter and Paul in Galatians 2:8)
  - -Paul was "energized" to minister to the Gentiles and Peter was "energized" to minister to the Jews.
- 4. Phanerosis- Manifestations (1 Corinthians 12:7-10; 28-30)

## Romans 12:3-8

In verses 3-5 we see four characteristics of the body of Christ as we look at spiritual gifts:

- 1. Equality (v.3) Everyone has worth and value. No one is better than another.
- 2. Diversity (v. 4) There are many gifts in the church. We are not all alike.
- 3. Unity (v. 5a) Though there are many gifts, we are one in Christ. There is a unity of the Holy Spirit that we must preserve.
- 4. Reciprocity (v. 5b) We need each other. There is mutual dependence in the body of Christ.
